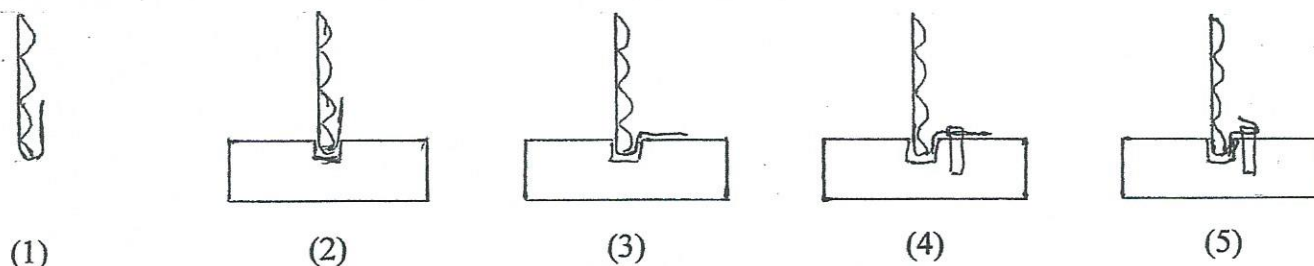


# MDF Frames with Plastic Corners

**Corners Available** in National, Commercial, Smith or Langstroth lugs

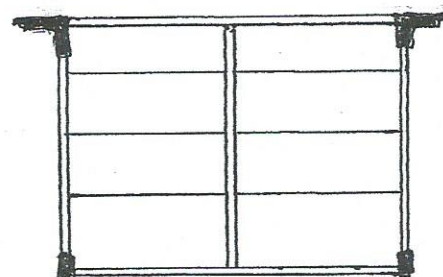
**WIRED FOUNDATION** Can be fixed to the top bar using 6mm light duty (series 53) staples as follows:-  
 1) Bend the wire loops against the foundation. 2) Fit to the foundation into the top bar groove. 3) Bend the loop out against the top bar. 4) Staple close to the foundation. 5) Bend the loop back over the staple.



The deeper brood frames, 40 x 12 etc., are supplied with a strip which fits to the foundation preventing bow and sag in the comb. This fits on one side of the foundation. It is held by three staples, is well worth doing, and does not generally offer any obstruction to the brood nest.

## **UNWIRED FOUNDATION**

Alternatively, use unwired foundation and wire horizontally. In this case the wires will tend to sag and bow with the foundation as the wires cannot be very tight without bending the sidebars. Here again the vertical strip on one side of the foundation is of considerable help.



**Damp MDF Expands** If difficult to assemble frames, dry out for 20 mins in oven gas mark 2 (150° C)
